Day 01 : ARRIVE DELHI

You will arrive from landon to Delhi airport ; meet & greet by our representative after which you will be transferred to your respective hotel.

India's capital and a major gateway to the country, contemporary Delhi is a bustling metropolis, which successfully combines in its folds - the ancient with the modern. Amidst the fast spiraling skyscrapers the remnants of a bygone time in the form of its many monuments stand as silent reminders to the region's ancient legacy. The first impressions for any visitor traveling in from the airport are of a specious, garden city, tree-lined with a number of beautiful parks.



Upon arrival at the hotel, you will be accorded with a **Traditional Welcome**. Welcoming guest is an age-old tradition. 'Atithi Devobhava' - treat your guest as if he were God. Indian hospitality can be savored immediately as one arrives at the hotel. The guest's forehead is anointed with the traditional red 'tika' which is considered auspicious along with garlanding. Relax with a non-alcoholic welcome drink following which proceed to check in at your hotel. Overnight at the hotel.

Day : 2 DELHI

After buffet breakfast at the hotel you will proceed for the combined sightseeing tour of Delhi.

You will first visit **Old Delhi**. The tour visit to **Raj Ghat**, a simple memorial to Gandhi; **drive past the Red Fort**. After visiting Old Delhi, you will be driven to **New Delhi**, which reflects the legacy the British left behind.

The tour to Imperial Delhi will include a visit to the **Qutub Minar**, which is the tallest stone tower in India. The Qutub Minar was started in 1199 AD by Qutub-ud-Din Aibak and completed by the sultan's successor and son-in-law, Iltutmish. The building is 72.5 m high and has 379 steps from the bottom to the top. The Minar is tapering with the diameter of the base is 14.3 m while at the top floor it is 2.7 m. The Qutub Minar is still the highest stone tower as well as one of the finest Islamic structures ever raised in India. Then visit **Humayun's tomb**, built by the widow of the second Mughal Emperor, Humayun, it is an outstanding monument in the Indo-Persian style, a precursor of the Taj Mahal. The tour also includes a drive past the imposing **India Gate**, the **Parliament building** and the **Rashtrapati Bhawan**, the President's residence.



In the evening after city tour, return to the hotel.


Day 3 : DELHI - AGRA

After breakfast, you will be driven to Agra 250 Kms 06 Hours Drive. proceed for a **tour of the Taj Mahal (closed on Fridays)**. The Taj Mahal is everything that



has been said about it and more. Taking 22 years and 20,000 men to build, the white marble was quarried 200 miles away and was transported to the site by a fleet of 1000 elephants. Built by the Mughal Emperor Shah Jahan as an expression of his love for his wife Mumtaz Mahal, in mid 17th century, the Taj Mahal is truly one of the wonders of the world. Though the Taj appears to be amazingly perfect from almost any angle, it is the close-up marble inlay work, which is really astounding. You will have ample time to view and be mesmerized by this outstanding piece of architecture.

Come back to your hotel for buffet breakfast following which you will proceed to visit Agra Fort. **Agra Fort** is an outstanding example of Mughal architecture. Agra Fort - the seat and the stronghold of the Mughal Empire under successive generations. This was the seat of Mughal rule and administration and



the present structure owes its origins to Akbar who erected the walls and gates and the first buildings on the eastern banks of Yamuna River. Shah Jehan added the impressive quarters and the mosque while Aurangzeb added the outer ramparts. Visit its Hall of Public Audience and its Royal Pavilions.

Return to the hotel after sightseeing tour.

Day 04 : AGRA – FATEHPUR SIKRI - RANTHAMBORE

After buffet breakfast at the hotel, you will be driven from Agra to Ranthambore (300 KMS / 8 hours) en-route **visiting Fatehpur Sikri**, the deserted red sandstone city, built by the Great Mughal Emperor Akbar as his capital and palace in the late 16th century. It was abandoned soon after it was built when the local wells went dry and it remains today in much the same condition that it was over 300 years ago. It is complete with palaces and mosques and used to be a town larger than London when it was originally constructed.

Over Night at Ranthambhore.

Day 05 : RANTHAMORE

Proceed on early morning Jeep game viewing at the Ranthambore Wildlife Sanctuary which covers an area of 392 sq kms of thick forests. One can spot predators like the Tiger and Leopard and other carnivorous animals like the Hyena, Jackal and Sloth Bear. The sanctuary also abounds in Wild Boar and various varieties of deer like Spotted Deer, Sambhar, Chinkara and Nilgai. The common Langaur (monkey) abound in the trees. Return to Hotel.

After Lunch proceed for 02nd Game drive in Afternoon Ranthambore Wildlife Sanctuary
Overnight at Hotel.

Day 06 : RANTHAMBHORE TO JAIPUR

After Breakfast Drive from to Jaipur & Check inn to the Hotel & In the afternoon you will visit the **city of the highlights** to be seen while touring the **City Palace**, which is an complex of exquisite palaces, gardens decorative art and carved doorways. museum houses collections of rare armory, costumes, carpets and paintings. Walk to the adjacent **Jantar**



Astronomical Observatory made by the Jaipur, built in 1726 and is one of the five such astronomical wonders built by Sawai Jai Singh and makes accurate predictions even to this day. Then you will stop and see the '**Palace of Winds**', otherwise known as Hawa Mahal. It is really an elaborate facade behind which the ladies of the court used to watch the daily goings on in the street below. It is extremely intricate in its pink sandstone carving. The cool wind blows through its facade of windows and latticed screens through which the queens of the court once viewed the streets of the city. You will also have the opportunity to wander about the local markets.



Day 07 : JAIPUR

After buffet breakfast at the hotel, you will be driven just outside Jaipur to the **ancient capital of Amber** to see the fabulous Amber Fort.



Maharaja Mansingh, Mughal Emperor Akbar's most successful General, started the construction of Amber Fort in the 17th century. Before the City Palace was constructed in Jaipur, Amber was the seat of power.

An elephant /Jeep will spare you the trouble of reaching up to the fortress (*Elephant ride is subject to availability*) once on top, stroll through the sprawling complex of courtyards and halls.

Many of the rooms have delightful wall paintings, with precious stones and mirrors inlaid in the walls. Most fascinating, perhaps, is the Sheesh Mahal (hall of mirrors) where a single lamplight is reflected in the many mirrors, lighting up the room. Come back to your hotel after your excursion.

Day 08 : JAIPUR

After buffet breakfast at the hotel, you will be driven for Jaipur Airport to connect your further destination.
